1. Wear the glasses you normally wear when reading.
2. Hold the chart at arms length and cover one eye. With the uncovered eye, stare at the white dot in the center of the grid.



3. To place the chart at the correct test

distance, slowly bring the chart toward your eye until one of the two red ovals FIRST disappear.

4. During the entire test, you should have one eye covered, stare at the center of the grid, and only see one red oval.
5. You should be able to see the center white dot and the four corners and sides of the grid. The lines should appear to be straight and continuous from top to bottom and side to side. If not, call your eye doctor. If there are any holes or blurry spots, or if the lines appear to be wavy, fuzzy, crooked, distorted, or broken, call your eye doctor. Now test your other eye.
